



# Hygienic protection concept FISB

## **Organizational matters**

- Emails and posts on the FISB website will be used to ensure that all FISB members are sufficiently informed.
- With the resumption of sports activities, FISB members informed their employees, coaches, team leaders and athletes about the relevant rules and concepts.
- At competitions, the organizer will inform the participants of the local hygiene rules.
- Compliance with the rules will be checked regularly by the coach or the team leader. Non-compliance will prohibit participation in training and competitions.

## **General safety and hygiene rules**

- We inform our event participants that there is a minimum separation between people of 1.5 meters, both indoors and outdoors.
- All physical contact (eg greeting, farewell, etc.) is prohibited.
- People with symptoms of illness are prohibited from participating in events, competitions and training.
- Participants are regularly advised to wash their hands sufficiently and disinfect them regularly.
- There is a general obligation to cover the mouth and nose, both indoors and outdoors, if the minimum separation of 1.5 meters between people cannot be observed.
- Our members were asked to wear a mask when carpooling with people from different households.
- Snacks and drinks, apart from the main meals, are to be provided by the participants themselves. Sharing is strictly prohibited.

## **Additional measures**

- Sport is practiced in all disciplines, without physical contact and respecting a minimum separation between people of 1.5 meters.
- The opening ceremonies and the award ceremonies are to be held outdoors if possible.
- All competitions and other events will be documented using the participant health questionnaires to provide “Track and Trace” information in the event of infection.
